

OVERVIEW



Wahpeton Expansion Project

- WBI Energy plans to build, operate and maintain the Wahpeton Expansion Project.
- WBI Energy will construct approximately 60 miles of 12-inch diameter natural gas pipeline, connecting the company's existing pipeline system at its Mapleton Compressor Station with two new delivery facilities near Wahpeton and Kindred.
- WBI Energy will make minor modifications at its existing Mapleton Compressor Station to connect the project to the existing pipeline system.

Why is this project proposed?

- The Wahpeton Expansion Project will allow WBI Energy to transport an additional 20.6 million cubic feet of natural gas per day to help meet growing demand in southeastern North Dakota.
- Montana-Dakota Utilities Co. has engaged WBI Energy to construct this project to fulfill Wahpeton customers' needs for additional uninterrupted gas supply.
- As part of this project, Montana-Dakota Utilities Co. will extend natural gas service to Kindred for the first time, at the request of city officials and residents.
