SURVEYS & FIELD STUDIES

As part of the planning process for the new pipeline route, WBI Energy will conduct civil and environmental field surveys and site evaluations. Surveys and studies help WBI Energy find a feasible route that minimizes environmental impacts. Data collection is scheduled for Fall 2021 and will include:

- Vegetation and wildlife habitat
- Waterbodies and wetlands
- Noxious weeds
- Land use
- Cultural resources (historic properties, districts, cultural artifacts or buildings)
