Dear Ms. Myerchin,

I grant WBI Energy Transmission, Inc.'s (WBI Energy) September 10, 2021 request to place the Temple valve setting in Williams County, North Dakota, back into service at its previous certificated volume level. The valve setting is associated with the North Bakken Expansion Project and the partial in-service is necessary to continue providing natural gas service to WBI Energy's existing customers during construction of the project. Your request complies with environmental condition 11 of the Commission's June 1, 2021 *Order Issuing Certificate* (Order) issued in the above-referenced docket. Based on our compliance monitor's inspection and WBI Energy's recent status reports, I find that WBI Energy has demonstrated that the disturbed area is stabilized with erosion controls and WBI Energy commits to completing restoration of the disturbed area by October 2021.
