Re: Partial In-Service Authorization

I grant WBI Energy Transmission, Inc.'s (WBI Energy) July 27, 2021 request to place into service a minor reroute of the 12-inch Williston-Tioga-Minot mainline through WBI Energy's existing Tioga Compressor Station in Williams County, North Dakota. This partial in-service is necessary to continue providing natural gas service to WBI Energy's existing customers during construction within the Tioga Compressor Station at currently certificated volume levels.

Your request is in compliance with environmental condition 11 of the Commission's June 1, 2021 Order Issuing Certificate (Order) issued in the abovereferenced docket. Although construction, stabilization, and restoration are not complete at this time, WBI Energy will continue to monitor and address any erosion and sediment control issues, until construction of the Tioga Compressor Station expansion, the 20-inch-diameter Tioga Lateral Pipeline, and associated Project-related construction at the area is completed.
