SURVEYS & FIELD STUDIES

As part of the planning process for the new pipeline route, WBI Energy will conduct civil and environmental field surveys and site evaluations. Surveys and studies help us map the best route and minimize environmental impacts. Data collection is scheduled for June 2019 and will include:

- Vegetation and wildlife habitat.
- Endangered species.
- Wetlands and waterbodies.
- Cultural resources (historic properties, districts, cultural artifacts or buildings).

REGULATORY PERMITS & APPROVALS

Environmental data will be included during regulatory review of the project. Agencies involved in the review include:

- Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) — Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity.
- U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.
