Responses to Environmental Information Request on November 25, 2020

FEDERAL ENERGY REGULATORY COMMISSION

General – Request No. 1

Provide a response to comments from the Hartels regarding a multi-well pad in the SWSW of Section 23 of their property. Specifically, file a map that identifies the location of this multi-well pad, clarify the distance from this multi-well pad to the Project area, and discuss how the Project could impact development of infrastructure at, and connecting to, this well pad.

Response:

A map showing the location of the referenced multi-well pad in relation to WBI Energy Transmission, Inc.'s (WBI Energy) North Bakken Expansion Project (Project) workspace is presented below (Figure 1). As shown in the map, the multi-well pad is located over 0.6 mile north of the Project workspace near milepost (MP) 53.6 of the Tioga-Elkhorn Creek pipeline. The entrance to the multi-well pad is located on the west side of the multi-well pad off of 122nd Avenue NW just north of 26th Street NW while all Project-related workspace is located to the south and east of the facility. Due to the distance between the Project workspace and the multi-well pad and because the access for the site is on the opposite side of the facility as the Project workspace, it is unlikely that the Project will have an effect on the multi-well pad or any associated infrastructure at, or connecting to, the well pad. If any future facilities associated with the multi-well pad are identified with potential to be affected by the Project, WBI Energy will work with the owner of the facility to minimize Project-related impacts.



Responses to Environmental Information Request on November 25, 2020

General - Request No. 2

Based on ambiguity between attachment A of WBI Energy's Horizontal Directional Drill/Guided Bore Drilling Fluid Monitoring Plan ("Directional Drill Contingency Plans WBI Lake Sakakawea Crossing," page 2); WBI Energy's Horizontal Directional Drill/Guided Bore Drilling Fluid Monitoring and Operations Plan at section 6.1.2; and WBI Energy's response to question 4 of our February 4, 2020 comments on WBI Energy's draft applicant-prepared environmental assessment, clarify:

- a. the frequency with which visual inspection would occur along the Lake Sakakawea alignment (in particular the over-water portion); and
- b. how these inspections would be conducted (e.g., from land-based areas, via boat, via unmanned aerial vehicle).

Response:

The drill path will be inspected for inadvertent returns by WBI Energy or their contractors as follows:

- The land-based portion of the right-of-way will be inspected by foot or vehicle at a minimum of once every 6 hours during daylight hours.
- The water-based portion of the right-of-way will be inspected by unmanned drone at a minimum of once every 4 hours during daylight hours.
- During all hours, if a large reduction or sudden loss of drilling fluid is detected, monitors will be dispatched immediately to monitor for inadvertent returns of drilling fluid at the land surface and on Lake Sakakawea.

If WBI Energy has been unable to obtain access to these parcels or negotiate an acceptable easement agreement for these aboveground facilities, identify when access and/or an acceptable easement agreement is expected.

Response:

Table 1 below provides an update on the status of WBI Energy's easement negotiations for parcels where Project aboveground facilities are located. Where access to the parcel or an acceptable easement agreement has not yet been obtained, WBI Energy has identified when access or an acceptable easement agreement is expected.

Resource Report 1 – Request No. 2

Provide justification why each workspace cannot be set back further to accommodate the 50 feet from wetlands required in the FERC Procedures.

Response:

As noted in table 1.3-1 provided in WBI Energy's September 11, 2020 Supplemental Filing, WBI Energy is requesting modifications to sections V.B.2 and VI.B.I of the FERC's Procedures. The text below provides additional information for each workspace identified in table 1.3-1 and justification as to why the workspace cannot be set back further to accommodate the requirements of the FERC Procedures.

- Locate workspace at MP 30.2 of the Tioga-Elkhorn Creek pipeline within 50 feet of the water's edge. The workspace identified for the crossing of Tobacco Garden Creek at MP 30.2 cannot be set back further given the angle of the crossing and two points of intersect (PIs) in close proximity. The requested workspaces are necessary to safely complete the bore crossing.
- Locate workspace at MP 52.5 of the Tioga-Elkhorn Creek pipeline within 50 feet of an emergent wetland. A small emergent wetland is located on the south side of the crossing of Cherry Creek, about 27 feet from the additional temporary workspace needed for the crossing of Cherry Creek. WBI Energy has completed multiple crossings of Cherry Creek on past projects and the length of the bore and location/size of temporary workspaces have been designed to minimize impacts in an area prone to erosion. This wetland is located within the temporary right-of-way and will be temporarily impacted during construction. In this instance, a further off set of temporary workspaces from the emergent wetland would not provide any further protection, given that the wetland is located within the temporary right-of-way.
- Locate two workspaces at MP 0.8 of the Line Section 25 Loop within 50 feet of an emergent wetland. Line Section 25 Loop in this area will be constructed with a series of three bores within less than a 0.5 mile stretch of pipeline. The wetland in question (w-wm-wb-002e) is a U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service wetland basin that is required to be crossed by bore. Given the additional constraints in this area (cultural resources, existing pipeline infrastructure, additional U.S. Fish and Wildlife wetland basins) the proposed route and workspaces are required to safely complete these bores.
- Locate workspace at MP 1.0 of the Line Section 25 Loop within 50 feet of an emergent wetland. This workspace on the north side of 69th Street NW is necessary to facilitate a guided bore crossing of the road. As noted above, there are various constraints in this area (cultural resources, existing pipeline infrastructure, additional U.S. Fish and Wildlife wetland basins) that brought the route and workspaces to their proposed location. There are three emergent wetlands located in proximity to this road crossing, one of which has an additional temporary workspace located within 50 feet. Shifting the workspace to the north would bring the workspace within 50 feet of a different wetland. Given the location of the road and PIs the proposed workspace location is necessary to safely complete this bore.
- Locate workspace at MP 14.8 of the Line Section 25 Loop within 50 feet of an emergent wetland. This workspace on the east side of 100th Ave NW is necessary to facilitate a guided bore crossing of the road. The wetland in question (w-bk-wa-001e) is located immediately adjacent to the road.

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Given the location of the road and wetland, attempting to minimize the length of the bore while maintaining colocation, and PIs associated with the bore, the proposed workspace location is necessary to safely complete this bore.

- Locate workspace at MP 16.2 of the Line Section 25 Loop within 50 feet of an emergent wetland.
 The workspace on the west side of 99th Avenue NW is necessary to safely facilitate a guided bore
 crossing of the road and wetland. Sufficient space is present at this location to accommodate a 50foot setback from the emergent wetland.
- Locate workspace at MP 0.4 of the Tioga Compressor Lateral within 50 feet of an emergent wetland. The workspace on the west side of 103rd Avenue NW is needed to cross the road by guided bore and enter the Tioga Compressor Station. As work will be ongoing within the Tioga Compressor Station on the east side of the road, temporary workspaces on the west side of the road are needed to complete the bore. Given the location of the wetland to the road crossing, shifting the workspace to be 50 feet from the wetland would not be possible while maintaining the space needed to safely complete this road crossing.
- Locate workspace at uprate bore site 3 within 50 feet of an emergent wetland. The work to be completed at the uprate bore locations is dictated by the location of the existing pipeline which will be replaced and rerouted at the crossing of 92nd Street NW. The bore has been designed to have the majority of workspaces on the north side of the road away from the majority of wetlands. The portion of the additional temporary workspace that is within 50 feet of an emergent wetland is necessary to be able to safely complete this uprate bore.
- Locate workspace at uprate bore site 4 within 50 feet of an emergent wetland. The work to be completed at the uprate bore locations is dictated by the location of the existing pipeline which will be replaced and rerouted at the crossing of 93rd Street NW. This road crossing is surrounded by wetlands. The bore has been designed to have the majority of workspaces on the north side of the road away from the majority of wetlands. The portion of the additional temporary workspace that is within 50 feet of an emergent wetland is necessary for the bore pullback.

Responses to Environmental Information Request on November 25, 2020

Resource Report 1 – Request No. 3

Provide justification as to why a travel lane would be required between the entry and exit workspaces at several of the guided bore crossings that would impact sensitive resources.

Response:

A travel lane will be required during construction between the entry and exit workspaces at the following guided bore crossings of sensitive resources: Beaver Creek (s-wm-eb-002), wetland w-mk-ea-004e, Northfork Creek (s-mk-eb-005), and Cherry Creek (s-lbt-001a). Construction matting and temporary bridging installations will limit the overall impacts to no more than minimal at these crossings, thus minimizing impacts overall. Justification for each travel lane is provided below:

- Beaver Creek (s-wm-eb-002; MP 18.2 of Tioga to Elkhorn Creek pipeline) a travel lane is necessary to expedite the construction of this waterbody crossing given the distance to access roads. The driving distance from one side of the bore to the other using proposed access roads and public roads would be 2.6 miles.
- Emergent Wetland (w-mk-ea-004-e; MP 47.0 of Tioga to Elkhorn Creek pipeline) a travel lane is necessary to expedite the construction of this wetland crossing given the distance to access roads. The driving distance from one side of the bore to the other using proposed access roads and public roads would be 2.1 miles.
- Northfork Creek (s-mk-eb-005; MP 51.5 of Tioga to Elkhorn Creek pipeline) a travel lane is
 necessary to expedite the construction of this waterbody crossing given the lack of access roads in
 this area. There are no proposed access roads or public roads that would provide access to both
 sides of this bore crossing.
- Cherry Creek (s-lbt-001a; MP 52.4 of Tioga to Elkhorn Creek pipeline) a travel lane is necessary to expedite the construction of this waterbody crossing given the lack of access roads in this area. There are no proposed access roads or public roads that would provide access to both sides of this bore crossing. WBI Energy is committed to working with the landowner on this parcel (Hartels) on any concerns they may have with the crossing of Cherry Creek.

Response:

Based on the current Project alignment, the total acreage of the archaeological survey area is 4,316.7 acres, of which 4,261.6 acres (99 percent) have been surveyed to date.

Response:

The total area of the current survey corridor that remains to be surveyed totals 55.1 acres. These areas have yet to be surveyed due to lack of landowner permission.

Resource Report 4 – Request No. 3

Provide the total number of archaeological sites (prehistoric, historic, and multicomponent), isolated finds, and historic structures identified during the archaeological surveys. Provide the total number of archaeological sites that were tested as part of the Project. Provide the total number of National Register of Historic Places-eligible, not eligible, or unevaluated archaeological resources.

Response:

The summary of sites below includes those sites reported in the following reports for the Project:

- ERM's Class III Archaeological Inventory Survey and Testing WBI Energy Transmission, Inc. North Bakken Expansion Project, Burke, McKenzie, Mountrail, and Williams Counties, North Dakota submitted to FERC on September 11, 2020.
- Beaver Creek Archaeology's Class III Cultural Resources Inventory of the North Bakken Pipeline (Hartel Parcel) in McKenzie County, North Dakota submitted to FERC on September 11, 2020.
- ERM's Class III Archaeological Survey Addendum Report 1 WBI Energy Transmission, Inc. North Bakken Expansion Project, Burke, McKenzie, Mountrail, and Williams Counties, North Dakota submitted to FERC on November 13, 2020.

A total of 139 archaeological sites, isolated finds, and site leads were recorded during the class III survey in support of the Project. A total of 99 archaeological sites have been reported on for this Project, including 75 prehistoric sites, 16 historic sites, and 8 multicomponent sites. There were 26 isolated finds that were recorded and tested during the course of the investigation, including 25 prehistoric isolated finds and 1 historic isolated find. A total of 14 site leads were also examined, consisting of 11 prehistoric site leads and 3 historic site leads (see tables 3 and 4). In addition to the archaeological resources, 18 historic structures were also documented within the study area (see table 4).

Additional archaeological testing was completed at 17 archaeological sites during the 2020 field season. Initially, two additional sites had been slated for additional testing, but the route was shifted to avoid them and they were not investigated further. Testing at two other sites was started but not completed due to the discovery of stone features within the site boundary, necessitating that all subsurface activities cease. All digging at these sites was suspended in accordance with the State Historical Society of North Dakota-approved work plan mandating that no digging occur within the vicinity of stone features identified on the surface.

Of the archaeological sites, isolated finds, and site leads examined for the class III inventory, 5 are considered eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP), 52 sites are considered ineligible, and 82 sites remain unevaluated for listing in the NRHP. Of the historic structures identified, 7 are recommended ineligible for listing in the NRHP and 11 structures remain unevaluated (see table 5).

Previously unfiled cultural correspondence is provided in Resource Report 4 Request No. 6 Attachments 1 and 2. Resource Report 4 Request No. 6 Attachment 2 has been filed under separate cover and marked "CUI//PRIV – DO NOT RELEASE." Previously unfiled BCA Agency and Tribal Correspondence is provided in Resource Report 4 Request No. 6 Attachment 3. Please note that additional correspondence was also filed on November 13, 2020.

As outlined in the attached November 23rd meeting notes with the U.S. Forest Service (USFS), WBI Energy will be making two route changes to reduce the potential for impacts on cultural sites on USFS land. These meeting notes are included in Resource Report 4 Request No. 6 Attachment 1 – Previously Unfiled ERM Cultural Correspondence. The first route change will be on the east side of Highway 1806. The route will now bore under a cultural heritage site at the request of the USFS. Less than one acre of additional impact will be required for this route change. No new parcels will be impacted by this route change. No new wetlands or waterbodies will be impacted by this change. The bore path will also encompass an area of Dakota Skipper reproductive habitat, for which boring is an acceptable measure of avoidance. WBI Energy will install fencing as needed so no travel between bore entry and exit points would be permitted. The length of this new bore is estimated to be 650 feet and the depth is estimated to be 10 feet. The bore will be located in the "Bullion Creek / River, Lake and Swamp" geologic formation.

The second route change will be on the west side of Highway 1806. WBI Energy will move an additional temporary workspace from the south side of the right-of-way to the north side of the right-of-way to increase the distance from the Project workspaces to a cultural site. Additionally, the route will extend further to the west by about 100 feet before heading south and boring under a tributary to Tobacco Garden Creek (s-mk-wa-001) and Highway 1806 at a different angle to increase the distance from Project workspace to multiple cultural sites. Less than two acres of additional impact will be required for this route change. No new parcels will be impacted by this route change. No new wetlands or waterbodies will be impacted by this route change. No changes to the originally proposed bore length or depth are anticipated.

LOG OF CONVERSATION:

- Andrea Thornton (ERM) welcomed everyone to the meeting. Ms. Thornton (ERM)
 provided background information describing the routing process for the North Bakken
 Expansion Project (Project) to date. She presented the first route WBI Energy examined
 and explained that WBI Energy first explored keeping the proposed line close to the
 energy corridor that was approved as part of the Gunslinger Well Pad Environmental
 Assessment.
- Ms. Thornton (ERM) continued to explain that in consultation with the USFS WBI Energy was asked to move the route closer to the highway along a segment of the route; however, cultural sites continued to be found during the survey process. She explained that the major constraints that were found during the routing process included the number of cultural sites identified, the presence of Dakota Skipper reproductive habitat, and the presence of existing and proposed projects including well pad development. As a result, WBI moved the route to the west side of the highway. The original route on the west side was proposed paralleling the highway, however additional cultural sites were found which continued to push the route further west.
- Ms. Thornton (ERM) noted that some of the cultural sites identified during field surveys
 are closer to the approved energy corridor than the proposed Project route, and
 illustrated this on a mapping tool to show the location of existing lines and the approved
 corridor.
- Pat Robblee (ERM) described how WBI Energy got to the 50 foot buffer. Given that this
 is a FERC regulated Project, WBI Energy initially started with a 25 foot buffer, FERC's
 general avoidance rule, as a baseline. Then, through conversations with Andy Clark at
 the SHSND, they requested a 50 foot buffer with a commitment to fence and monitor the
 sites during construction.



- Ms. Bigelow (USFS) noted that though FERC is the lead federal agency, they don't direct how the USFS manages the lands and its resources. She stated that SHPO and FERC don't direct how the USFS manages the sites on their land. Ms. Bigelow agreed that a 50 foot buffer can work if there is an eligibility determination made on the site, but if a determination has not been made based on surface or subsurface materials, then it is impossible to know the extent of the sites or their boundaries. Not having eligibility determinations hamstrings the ability of the USFS. She noted the USFS is responsible for any damage to a site on USFS land.
- Mr. Robblee (ERM) noted that the reason that subsurface testing wasn't done in order to make eligibility derminations was because of the insistence by the tribes that no subsurface testing be conducted around stone feature sites. Mr. Robblee stated that WBI Energy laid out the proposed methods in the testing plan that was approved by agencies. With regards to the determination, WBI Energy had come to a resolution with the SHPO that, given the inability to make a determination, sites would be left as unevaluated and have a 50 foot buffer. Ms. Bigelow (USFS) stated that USFS has always requested for full eligibility determinations.
- Mr. Robblee (ERM) asked if the requested 150 foot buffer is applied uniformly to all USFS lands or is it specific to this particular grasslands. Ms. Bigelow (USFS) responded that the 150 foot buffer is a typical starting point and it may change project to project, but it is standard practice.
- Ms. Bigelow (USFS) than asked if she was correct that not all of the sites on USFS land
 were stone feature sites. Mr. Robblee (ERM) stated that there is one historic site near
 the west side and a second site with both historic and prehistoric features. He noted that
 there are other historic sites that were identified but that are located hundreds of feet
 away from the current route. With the exception of these two sites, the rest of the sites
 are stone feature sites.
- Andrea Kruse (USFS) asked if WBI Energy could adjust the route on the west side of the highway to achieve a 150 buffer because those sites [32MZ3380, 32MZ3379] are located in areas without any pipeline development. Ms. Thornton (ERM) stated that this is something WBI Energy can look into but cannot be committed to at this time. Mr. Robblee (ERM) noted that that particular area is also difficult because of boring under Tobacco Garden Creek.
- Andrea Kruse (USFS), asked about the sites [32MZ3389, 32MZ3390] near the pull back for the bore beneath HWY 1806 and Ms. Thornton (ERM) explained how construction of the bore would take place. Ms. Kruse (USFS) asked ERM to make it clear in the Avoidance Plan that the workspaces in this area would be used for the bore pull back and no digging would occur.
- Ms. Thornton (ERM) pointed out site [32MZ3383] on the eastern side of the road where the cultural heritage site boundary is much larger than the archeological site boundary (which is currently being avoided by 50 feet). Ms. Thornton (ERM) asked for clarification



about whether the USFS considers boring to be avoidance. Ms. Bigelow (USFS) stated that is considered avoidance.

- Mr. Robblee (ERM), suggested that as a next step WBI Energy look at the areas where there are pinch points and how the comments can be addressed. Ms. Thornton (ERM) asked what happens if a site cannot be avoided by 150 feet.
- Ms. Bigelow (USFS) stated that she is trying to balance the work and agreements that have occurred prior to her taking over this district. She discussed the issues regarding an archaeological monitor and a high visibility fence. She noted that having a monitor is typically only effective if you have them out there sifting through back dirt which is not practicable because of safety. USFS has had more success with increasing buffers and making sure that the operators have the list of people who are to be called if there's an accidental incursion into a site. She stated that she would like to see really good fencing and really good instructions about what happens if there is an unanticipated find. She stated that her preference for right now is for ERM and WBI Energy to look at the buffers are on a site by site basis to see if something more can done to help protect the sites.
- Mr. Robblee (ERM) agreed with these thoughts. He stated that on a FERC project there
 are also environmental monitors that are required to be on site and who are responsible
 for making sure that the client is adhering to the terms of the permit. They make sure
 fences go in where they're supposed to and stay in place so that those measures are
 maintained for the duration of the impact covered by the certificate of the project.
- Ms. Kruse (USFS) stated that she would like to see the boundaries of the sites that were considered an archaeology site and a cultural heritage site added to site forms, as well as stating that they are eligible for listing on the NRHP. Kevin Malloy (ERM) stated that language would be added to the forms. Mr. Robblee (ERM) suggested any site form edits wait until all updates that need to be added are known. Dr. Malloy (ERM) and Ms. Bigelow (USFS) agreed to hold off on those changes in order to send all of the updates at once.
- Ms. Thornton (ERM) stated that a next step would be to have a follow up call to go over buffers on a site by site basis. Ms. Bigelow (USFS) stated WBI Energy should feel free to reach out her with questions if Ms. Kruse (USFS) is not available.
- Ms. Thornton (ERM) concluded the call.

LOG OF CONVERSATION:

- Andrea Thornton (ERM) welcomed everyone to the meeting. She provided information
 on the status of the North Bakken Expansion (Project) and the Environmental
 Assessment schedule and the group discussed thoughts on how any potential route
 changes would be reflected in the FERC decision documents.
- Ms. Thornton (ERM) then shared her screen and ran through the proposed route on USFS land in relation to cultural sites and areas where the route or workspaces could be modified to increase the buffer between the site and Project workspaces. She noted that all possible changes would occur within the current survey coverage of the Project.
- Ms. Thornton (ERM) stated that WBI Energy was not proposing to make any changes along the northern portion of the route located on USFS lands. Andrea Kruse (USFS) stated she was ok with the current buffer of 32MZ3382 but requested the site be added that the avoidance plan. Kevin Malloy (ERM) stated that the site would be added to the avoidance plan.
- Ms. Thornton (ERM) then showed site 32MZ3383/CHFMZ76 and stated WBI Energy believed that this area could be bored to avoid the larger boundary of CHFMZ76. She also noted that the bore would encompass Dakota Skipper habitat.
- Ms. Thornton (ERM) stated WBI Energy is looking at a change along the western side of the road [to further avoid 32MZ3380/CHFMZ82]. She noted that this change may move the route slightly towards [CHFMZ81] and move further away from [CHFMZ84/32MZ3387] on the south side of the road in order to adjust the angle of the bore.



- Ms. Thornton (ERM) noted that there was little room to move anywhere along the
 western portion of the line within USFS lands so no changes were proposed to the west.
 Ms. Kruse (USFS) and Ms. Bigelow (USFS) agreed.
- Ms. Kruse (USFS) asked about 32MZ3321 and why an eligibility determination was not made. Dr. Malloy (ERM) stated that some shovel testing was done at the site but that it could not continue to the west due to the slope and topography in this area. He stated a recommendation wasn't made because the site was only examined at the Phase I level. Since the route was moved away from the site to a distance of over 50 feet, no testing to make a determination was done.
- Ms. Thornton (ERM) asked if there were any other questions and if everyone was satisfied with the route modifications that were discussed. Ms. Bigelow (USFS), Ms. Kruse (USFS), Cale Bickerdyke (USFS), and Jill Linn (WBI Energy) confirmed they had no more questions. Ms. Thornton (ERM) concluded the meeting.

LOG OF CONVERSATION

I called North Dakota State Archaeologist, Andy Clark, to get clarification about buffer distances for sites that possess both Cultural Heritage Site boundaries and Archaeological Site boundaries that do not match. Andy stated that they use the 50 foot buffer as a rule of thumb. For the time being however, we should start with the 50 foot buffer for archaeological sites and simply note the sites that have cultural heritage boundaries that are within 50 feet. These would then be acknowledged in the overall project finding of effect. He also stated that THPOs would need to be consulted about these buffers and that the SHPO would give considerable weight to their opinions on the matters. Finally, he asked that I look at site 32MZ2939 in our Class III report and see if it wouldn't be better suited to the architectural report.
