Re: Notice to Proceed with Construction and Approval of Variances

Dear Ms. Myerchin:

I grant your February 5, 2024 request for WBI Energy Transmission, Inc. (WBI Energy) to commence all construction activities associated with the Wahpeton Expansion Project in Cass and Richland Counties, North Dakota.

In considering this notice to proceed, we have reviewed your Implementation Plan filed on December 1, 2023, as supplemented, which included the information necessary to meet the construction conditions of the Commission's October 23, 2023 *Order Issuing Certificate* (Order) in the above-referenced docket. In addition, we have confirmed the receipt of all federal authorizations relevant to the approved activities herein.

Additionally, I approve the following variances as filed with your Implementation Plan:

- The addition of a contractor yard, known as the 4 Sons LLC Yard;
- Modification of workspace and permanent access road at milepost (MP) 11.6 and MP 39.5;
- Rerouting of the pipeline from:
 - MP 26.7 to 27.2, and from MP 54.4 to 57.0, to follow the property line/collocate with a road at the landowners' requests;
 - MP 34.7 to 36.2 to follow the property line/railroad at the landowner's request; and
- Modification of permanent and temporary workspace at MP 48.9.
